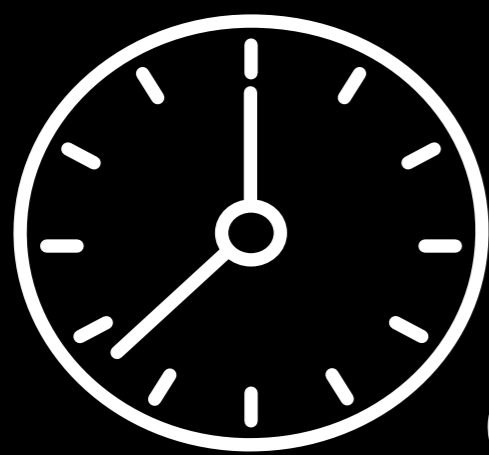
CALL YOUR VETERINARIAN

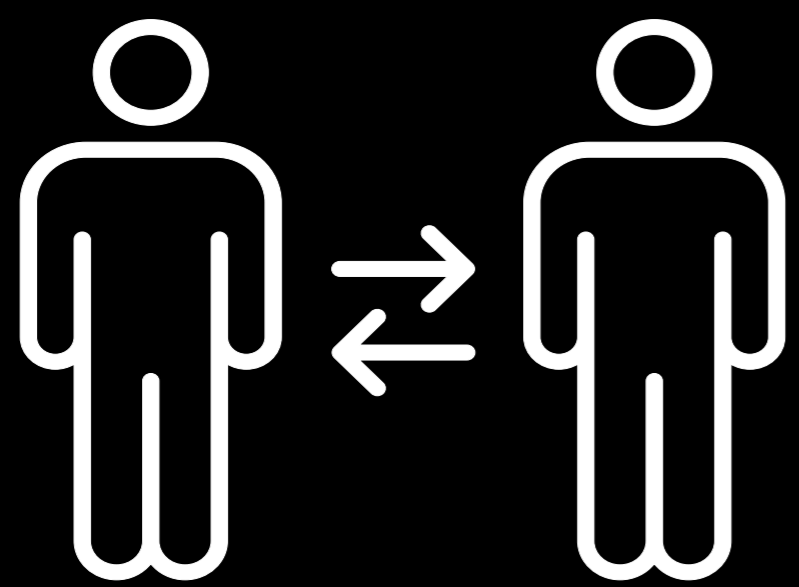
ASK ABOUT NEW PROTOCOLS
